Three Kansas City restaurants rank among top 100, OpenTable says

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The Kansas City area's The American Restaurant, Bluestem and Story are among the 100 best American restaurants, according to OpenTable's latest list.

Restaurants in 31 states [made the list](#), which was derived from more than 5 million reviews of more than 15,000 restaurants. OpenTable gathered feedback from November 2011 through October; those with the best reviews made the list.

The American has an overall rating of 4.7 out of 5 stars on OpenTable. Bluestem and Story each have ratings of 4.6.

Bluestem also [made the list last year](#). The only other Kansas City-area restaurant on the 2011 list was Room 39, but it didn't make the latest list.

Texas took the most spots on the list with 10; California followed with eight. The list also included one restaurant in Kansas — Harry's Restaurant in Manhattan — and three others in Missouri — Annie Gunn's in Chesterfield, Niche in St. Louis and Baxter's Lakeside Grille in Lake Ozark.
